Contestants will be asked to do some of following tasks in 6 minutes:

Open and shut a gate, go over a bridge, step over logs, ground tie or hobble the equine, pick up a slicker off the fence, get a magazine out of a mailbox, unbridle and re-bridle their equine, load and unload equine on trailer, drag a calf sled, basic reining pattern (including a rollback, stop and back up, and lead change), water crossing, call for cattle and box cattle at the end of the arena.

Advanced classes may be asked to turn the cow on the fence, circle or rope (may breakaway).

Equines may be ridden in more than one class, score stops when you run out of time.

Class Order of Competition: Tentative

* Jackpotted

- 1. 3-YEAR-OLD*:** Equine is three years of age, any rider can compete. Will breakaway rope.
- 2. LIMITED OPEN*:** Rider or equine cannot have won over \$750 (cash or prizes) in a Ranch Horse Competition.
- 3. LADIES' OPEN*:**
- 4. JUNIOR YOUTH 13 & UNDER:**
No roping.
- 5. OPEN*:** Open to any horse or rider.
- 6. AMATEUR:** Male & Female both in same class, no roping, rider has NEVER entered a Ranch Horse Competition before.
- 7. MEN'S RANCHER'S CLASS*:** Rider cannot have won over \$500 (cash or prizes) in the last three years, the equine must be owned by the ranch or rider for at least six months prior to competition.
- 8. LADIES' RANCHER'S CLASS*:** Same rules as men's rancher's class, no roping.
- 9. RANCH MULE: NEW THIS YEAR:**
No roping or fence work.
- 10. FEMALE ROOKIE*:** No roping, rider cannot have won over \$150 cash or prizes.
- 11. MALE ROOKIE*:** No roping, rider cannot have won over \$150 cash or prizes.
- 12. STICK RANCH HORSE:** Ages 6 & under.
